Our counselors will help you explore your options and how to move forward. You are not alone. We are there for you before, during and after your pregnancy.

As an all-options agency, whatever choice you make, we will respect, honor and support it.

- As the birth parent, you will choose the family that will adopt your baby.
- We will respect your needs and privacy throughout the process.
- Your counselor will work with you to determine which services best fit your needs.
- We can provide financial support to assist with your living expenses.
- Adoptive families who enter into our adoption program are thoroughly screened and assessed for safety.
- 6 Families are also committed to openness.

Part of choosing an adoptive family includes choosing what level of openness is best for you. We will support you in exploring the level of openness that best meets the needs of you, the baby and the adoptive family.

Our team is here to help you arrange and maintain contact for the years to come. You will have assistance with arrangements for family visits and letter and photo exchanges.

Birth fathers are also an important part of the decision making process and we value and support their role. We encourage both birth parents to participate in openness when choosing adoption.
